Guilty Plea in Albany Residential Break-In and Shooting



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that QUINTIN BROWN, 43, of Troy, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On January 26, 2019, at approximately 9:30 A.M., at a residence on Yardboro in the City of Albany, BROWN did unlawfully enter the residence of a female acquaintance. While

unlawfully inside the residence, BROWN fired multiple rounds from a firearm and caused physical injury to a victim by striking him in the head with the weapon.

BROWN faces up to 19 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on January 8, 2020.

Assistant District Attorneys Caroline Murray and Matthew Schrantz of the Special Victims Unit are handling the prosecution of this case.
