Guilty Plea in Domestic Homicide Case



ALBANY, NY - ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAMIEN ZERVOS, 32, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Manslaughter in the First Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Judge Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On October 31, 2013, at a residence on Lark Street in the City of Albany, the defendant did intentionally cause the death of Charee Akins-Maddox, 33, of Albany by shooting her with a rifle. At the time of the incident the victim's four children were inside the home.

ZERVOS will be sentenced to 25 years in State Prison on May 15, 2015.

Special Victims Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Sarfoh is handling the prosecution of this case.
