Guilty Plea to Reckless Endangerment During Domestic Incident



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **MICHAEL LOSTRITTO**, 35, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Reckless Endangerment in the First Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On January 12, 2015, at approximately 12:45 p.m., members of the Albany Police Department responded to a residence on Lindbergh Avenue in the City of Albany for a report of a domestic

incident involving a handgun. Inside, LOSTRITTO was threatening a victim that was known to him and her child with a loaded .9mm handgun. Police were able to enter the home, secure the weapon, and take LOSTRITTO into custody without further incident.

LOSTRITTO faces 2 1/3 to 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on April 17, 2015.

Assistant District Attorney Jennifer McCanney of the Special Victims Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
