Guilty Verdict after DWI Trial in Albany



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **DAVID BROZOWSKI**, 50, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Misdemeanor, (1) Count of Drinking Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle, and (1) Count of Sub-standard Lights, both Vehicle Traffic Law Infractions, before Judge Helena Heath in Albany City Court on February 26, 2016.

On February 3, 2015, at approximately 10:39 P.M., BROZOWSKI was observed by Albany City Police officers operating his vehicle in the area of Lake Avenue and Central Avenue in the City of Albany with no headlights. Following a traffic stop, BROZOWSKI was found to be operating his vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, and was found to be drinking alcohol while operating the vehicle.

BROZOWSKI was previously convicted of Driving While Ability Impaired in Bethlehem in 2010.

BROZOWSKI faces up to 1 year in jail when sentenced on April 29, 2016.

Assistant District Attorney Andrew Neidhardt prosecuted this case.
