Guilty Verdict in Albany Knife Assault Jury Trial



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KERON PITT, 21, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this afternoon.

The jury found that on August 1, 2016, at approximately 10:00 P.M., on First Street in the City of Albany, PITT entered into a physical altercation with an adult male who was known to him. PITT stabbed the victim multiple times in the torso with a knife and then fled. Members of the Albany Police Department responded to the scene and after an investigation PITT was arrested the next day. The victim survived the attack and was hospitalized for approximately two weeks after receiving surgery to his vital organs.

PITT faces 2 to 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on July 7, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Dennis DiBari of the Major Offense Unit prosecuted this case.
