Guilty Verdict in Cocaine Sale Trial



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAVID COOLEY, 26, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this afternoon.

An investigation led by the Albany Police Department did reveal that on July 9, 2013, in the vicinity of 616 Elk Street and Clinton Avenue in the City of Albany, COOLEY did sell a quantity of cocaine in exchange for US currency.

COOLEY, also known as “Man,” was remanded to the custody of the Albany County Correctional facility after the verdict. Due to previous criminal convictions that could aggravate sentencing guidelines, COOLEY faces up to 15 years in State Prison when sentenced on July 27, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Street Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
