Heroin Trafficker Pleads Guilty



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that EDMOND WILLIAMS, 48, of Troy, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Deborah Young in Albany County Court on Monday January 8, 2018 as a jury trial was set to commence.

An investigation led by the Albany Police Department uncovered that on September 20, 2016 and October 13, 2016, WILLIAMS sold approximately 3 grams of heroin in exchange for US Currency. On October 14, 2016, police executed a search warrant at the residence of WILLIAMS' mother in the City of Albany where they recovered 26 grams of heroin and 2.4

grams of crack cocaine. Around this time, a search warrant was also executed in WILLIAMS' residence in Troy. Approximately 39 grams of heroin were found in the refrigerator at each location.

WILLIAMS has six prior felony convictions and was out on bail in a separate case when this offense occurred. More information on WILLIAMS' case prior to this offense can be found [here](#).

WILLIAMS faces 2 years in State Prison, to be served consecutively to the 12 years he is currently serving for his previous drug conviction, when sentenced on March 6, 2018.

Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
