Jury Finds Woman Guilty of DWI



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that SHELBY GOYETTE, 25, of Albany, was found guilty of (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated Per Se, (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, and (1) Count of Following Too Closely, after a jury trial yesterday in Albany City Court before the Honorable Judge Helena Heath.

On August 27, 2015, GOYETTE was driving Westbound on I-90 when Albany Police pulled her over for following too closely behind a tractor trailer. Police noticed a strong odor of alcohol and slurred speech. She then failed the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. GOYETTE was taken back

to the Trooper Barracks, where she had a .15 Blood Alcohol Content.

GOYETTE faces up to 1 year in Albany County Jail, and/or 3 years of Probation, a \$1,000 fine, the installation of an Ignition Interlock Device for one year, and possible license revocation, subject to the Department of Motor Vehicles, when she is sentenced on December 4, 2015.

Assistant District Attorney Andrew Neidhardt is prosecuting this case.
