Latham Woman Sentenced for Attempted Assault



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that CHEONNE BRACE, 23, of Latham, was sentenced to 1 to 3 years in State Prison before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

On January 5, 2018, BRACE pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the Second Degree, a Class E Felony.

On June 28, 2017, at approximately 9 A.M., at Westminster Church in the City of Albany, BRACE intended to cause physical injury to a victim over the age of 65. On the above stated

date and time, BRACE went to the church to confront a person who BRACE believed was responsible for arranging to have her illegally parked car towed from the area. When the victim arrived in the vestibule area, BRACE attempted to drag the person out of the church while beating them. BRACE eventually fled the scene.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Major Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
