Man Arraigned for Burglary and Larceny Charges



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced that **MATTHEW WOELFERSHIEM**, 37, of Guilderland, was arraigned on (3) Counts of Burglary in the Third Degree, all Class D Felonies, (1) Count of Grand Larceny in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, (3) Counts of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree, all Class E Felonies, and (5) Counts of Petit Larceny, all Class A Misdemeanors, before Honorable Steven Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

The indictment that was unsealed in court today alleges that **WOELFERSHEIM** unlawfully entered a business on West Street in the City of Albany between July 25, 2012 and September 1, 2012, and did steal over \$1,000 of US Currency while inside. Further, the indictment alleges that **WOELFERSHEIM** unlawfully entered a residence on Watervliet Avenue in the City of Albany on the dates of August 28, 2013 and August 31, 2013, and did steal a sum of US Currency while inside on both occasions.

The indictment also alleges that **WOELFERSHEIM** did steal morphine from a local ambulance company in the City of Albany between August 16, 2012 and September 5, 2012.

The indictment also alleges that WOELFERSHEIM defrauded the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance in excess of \$3,000 between February 6, 2013 and June 6, 2013.

The indictment also alleges that WOELFERSHEIM stole in excess of \$1,000 from a local newsstand located in Albany County between March 11, 2013 and March 16, 2013, in addition to stealing in excess of \$1,000 from a local landscaping service in Albany County between April 25, 2013 and April 30, 2013.

The indictment also alleges that WOELFERSHEIM did steal US Currency from a victim in Albany County on April 29, 2013.

WOELFERSHEIM was remanded to the custody of the Albany County Correctional Facility with no bail.

WOELFERSHEIM was previously charged with multiple counts of felony Arson in the Third Degree in Guilderland Town Court, and those cases remain open and pending at this time.

Deputy Chief Assistant District Attorney Cheryl Fowler is handling the prosecution of this case.
