Man Pleads Guilty to Urban Mining



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ANTHONY ROSADO, 26, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On July 15, 2015, Menands Police Department received a phone call about someone being in a building. At approximately 2:29 p.m. in the area of 125 Broadway in the Village of Menands, Police saw ROSADO leaving the building. When he left, he had a backpack of tools and copper wire. He admitted to taking the copper from the second floor of the building.

ROSADO faces 6 months in Albany County Jail, to be followed by 5 years of Felony Probation,

when he is sentenced on November 9, 2015.

Assistant District Attorney Melinda Seiden-Fiorino of the Vehicular Crimes Unit is prosecuting this case.
