## **Man Pleads Guilty after High-Speed Crash into Car Containing Family of Four**



**CARR'S VEHICLE AFTER CRASH**

**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that TASHARON CARR, 26, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Reckless Endangerment in the First Degree, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On October 4, 2016, at approximately 7:20 P.M. on Everett Road in the City of Albany, members of the New York State Police Department initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle being driven by CARR after observing him commit a minor traffic offense. CARR fled from police and drove recklessly through traffic onto I-90 then into the City of Albany with police in pursuit. At the intersection between Lark Street and Third Street, CARR ignored a stop sign and crashed

into a vehicle containing a family of four, including two infants in the back seat. CARR then crashed the front of his vehicle into a tree. CARR fled from the vehicle and turned himself in later to New York State Police. Two adult passengers in the vehicle CARR crashed into were sent to a local hospital and were released after being treated for bone fractures. The infants in the rear of the vehicle were not injured.

CARR faces 1 1/2 to 3 years in State Prison when sentenced on April 28, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney David Szalda of the Vehicular Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
