Man Sentenced After Assaulting Woman with Crow Bar



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ANDREAU WOODS, 54, of Brooklyn, was sentenced to 15 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On July 29th, WOODS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Felony, (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, and (1) Count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, a Class A Misdemeanor.

On December 11, 2014, WOODS repeatedly hit a woman with a crow bar, resulting in multiple skull fractures, two wrist fractures, and a broken finger. Their 6-year-old child could hear the entire incident.

Assistant District Attorney Ariel Fallon of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
