## Man Sentenced for 2014 Slaying Outside of Albany Port Tavern



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that EDWARD MALLOY, 37, of Albany, was sentenced to 22 years to Life in State Prison before the Honorable Judge Richard Mott in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 10, 2015, MALLOY was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the

Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony. MALLOY was also sentenced today to serve 7 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, for the illegal weapon charge.

On February 16, 2014, outside of the Port Tavern on South Pearl Street in the City of Albany, MALLOY caused the death of Jamel Forbes by shooting him with a pistol.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Street Crimes Unit and Chief Assistant District Attorney David Rossi prosecuted this case.
