Man Sentenced for Stolen Dump Truck



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **SHERMAN CHAMBERS**, 43, of Albany, was sentenced to 2-4 years in State Prison, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On October 24 2017, **CHAMBERS** pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony.

On August 20, 2017, at approximately 2:27 PM, in the area of Beverly and Wilkins Avenue, in the City of Albany, CHAMBERS did knowingly possess stolen property with the intent to benefit himself. Specifically, CHAMBERS did possess a Chevy dump truck, which was reported stolen to the Albany Police Department.

CHAMBERS was also convicted and sentenced in 2004 for felony charges of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Major Offense Unit prosecuted this case.
