Motorist Sentenced for Aggravated Vehicular Assault That Left Victim With Amputated Leg



ALBANY, NY –District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ROBERT DUNN, 40, of Greenville, was sentenced to 2 1/3 to 7 years in State Prison before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On October 16, 2015, DUNN pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Vehicular Assault, a Class C Felony.

In the evening hours of June 22, 2014, in the vicinity of 502 County Route 111 in the Town of Coeymans, Dunn, who was driving an SUV while in an intoxicated condition, crossed the double solid line in the roadway, striking a motorcycle traveling in the opposite direction. The crash caused the driver of the motorcycle and his passenger to sustain serious physical injury, including amputation of her leg.

Subsequent to the collision, DUNN failed several of the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and was placed under arrest. Additionally, DUNN's blood alcohol content was more than twice the legal limit as he registered a .19 on a breath test that was administered to him at the police station.

Chief Assistant District Attorney Cheryl Fowler and Assistant District Attorney Dave Szalda of the Vehicular Crimes Unit are handling the prosecution of this case.
