Murder Indictment Unsealed in September Homicide



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAYTWAN PERKINS, 38, of Albany, was arraigned before Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning in relation to a September 2018 homicide that took place on North Swan Street in the City of Albany.

An indictment was unsealed this morning after an Albany County Grand Jury previously returned charges against PERKINS, alleging that he committed (1) Count of Murder in the

Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony.

The indictment unsealed today alleges that on the 11th day of September, 2018, at approximately 12:08 a.m. PERKINS caused the death of victim Barry Tyce, Jr. inside of 55 ½ North Swan Street in the City of Albany by means of shooting him with a loaded pistol.

PERKINS pleaded not guilty to the charges today in Court and remains in custody. No new appearance dates have been scheduled by the Court.

Street Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Jessica Blain-Lewis and Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane are handling the prosecution of this case.
