Operation Speeding Bullet: Albany Men Plead Guilty To Gun Possession



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **DANNY PEARSEON**, 42, of Albany and **MARVIN SANCHEZ**, 27, of Schenectady, both pleaded guilty in Albany County Supreme Court to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon, a Class D Violent Felony before the Honorable Joseph Teresi.

On November 1, 2012, Albany Police executed a search warrant at the residence of **PEARSON** on New Hope Terrace in the City of Albany. Upon a search of the residence, police discovered a loaded 9mm semi-automatic pistol as well a quantity of marijuana. **PEARSON** admitted to owning the pistol as well as the marijuana.

PEARSON faces 3 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision. **PEARSON** will be sentenced on January 22, 2013.

On April 16, 2012, **SANCHEZ** was stopped by Guilderland police on Carman Road in the Town of Guilderland. After **SANCHEZ** gave police consent to search the vehicle, police found two loaded .380 caliber semi-automatic pistols in the trunk. One of the firearms was reported stolen in Webster, NY in September 2010.

SANCHEZ faces 2 ½ years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on February 5, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Dan Lynch of the Street Crimes Bureau prosecuted both cases.
