Prison Sentence of 17 Years For Albany Armed Robbery



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KHALIM GILLEY, 22, of Albany, was sentenced to 17 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On February 26, 2015, GILLEY was found guilty after jury trial of (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Armed Felony, and (1) Count of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

On March 10, 2014, at approximately 1:35 a.m., while in the vicinity of 409 Madison Avenue, in the City of Albany, GILLEY, along with 3 co-defendants, one of whom displayed a sawed off shotgun, did forcibly steal property from another individual. GILLEY was later apprehended by the Albany Police Department

in the vehicle described by the victim and the victim's property was located inside the vehicle.

On April 1, 2015, co-defendant ELISHA WASHINGTON, 24, of Albany, pleaded guilty to an indictment charging (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Armed Felony, and (1) Count of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, before the Honorable Judge Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court, and faces up to 14 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on May 20, 2015.

Co-defendant ANTHONY SMITH, 25, of Albany, pleaded guilty to Attempted Robbery in the First Degree and will be sentenced to 3 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision.

Co-defendant KAREAM JACKSON, 26, of Albany, pleaded guilty to Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree and was sentenced to 2 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Offense Bureau is prosecuting these cases.
