Property Manager Pleads Guilty to Grand Larceny



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that JAMIE BONKOSKI, 41, of Cohoes, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Grand Larceny in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

Between January 11, 2013 and February 14, 2018, while employed as a property manager at Deer Valley Apartments in the Town of Guilderland, BONKOSKI stole money and property, forged signatures, opened fraudulent accounts, defrauded and stole from tenants, falsified business records, and defrauded the company over a period of time. A forensic audit spanning four years back determined the theft figure to be \$79,961.48.

BONKOSKI faces 1 to 3 years in State Prison when sentenced on December 5, 2018. Additionally, BONKOSKI will be subject to restitution in the amount of \$79,961.48.

Assistant District Attorney Shadi Masri is handling the prosecution of this case.
