Repeat DWI Offender Pleads Guilty



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JAMIL JORDAN, 30, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court today as a jury trial was set to commence.

On February 19, 2017, at approximately 5:45 A.M. in the Village of Menands, officers of the Menands Police Department found JORDAN pulled over on the median of I-787 with his reverse lights on, the driver's side door open, and the car rolling backwards. Officers observed JORDAN to have vomit on himself and outside of the car. Additionally, JORDAN was found to have three liquor bottles in the vehicle, 54 clonozepam pills, and 1.4 grams of crack cocaine, \$4,100, a

pocket knife, and a ski mask. When the officer attempted to arrest him, JORDAN became combative.

On January 23, 2017, JORDAN pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Vehicle in the First Degree, a Class E Felony and (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated as a Misdemeanor, and was sentenced on March 17, 2017 to 1 to 3 years in State Prison, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court. The above stated incident occurred while JORDAN was awaiting sentencing.

JORDAN faces 1 to 3 years in State Prison, to be served consecutively to the 1 to 3 years he is currently serving for his previous DWI and Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Vehicle conviction, when sentenced on April 10, 2018.

Assistant District Attorney Michael Shanley of the Vehicular Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
