Repeat Driver with Suspended License Pleads Guilty to Felony Charges



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today **JERRY McCLUSKEY**, 34, of Schoharie, pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Vehicle in

the First Degree, both Class E Felonies, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court on Tuesday.

On September 6, 2015, Albany City Police officers observed McCLUSKEY driving a Jeep Cherokee on Madison Avenue in the City of Albany at an excessive speed. Following a traffic stop it was discovered that McCLUSKEY was driving with a total of 26 license suspensions.

Approximately a week later, on September 17, 2015, Albany County Sheriff's deputies observed McCLUSKEY driving the same Jeep Cherokee with an excessively loud exhaust in the Town of Berne. Following a traffic stop it was discovered that McCLUSKEY was again driving with a suspended license.

On October 16, 2015, McCLUSKEY was observed driving away from Berne Town Court by the same Albany County Sheriff's deputy who arrested McCLUSKEY on September 17, 2015. McCLUSKEY's license was still suspended, with a total of 26 suspensions.

McCLUSKEY faces two back to back sentences of 1 year in Albany County Jail when he is sentenced on March 15, 2016.

Assistant District Attorney David Szalda of the Vehicular Crimes Bureau is handling the prosecution of this case.
