Repeat Drunk Driver Sentenced to 2 to 6 Years in Prison



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KENJUAN GREEN, 36, of Albany, was sentenced to 2 to 6 years in State Prison, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning. GREEN was also ordered upon release from custody to have a mandatory Ignition Interlock Device installed for 3 years, a 1 year license revocation subject to Department of Motor Vehicle determinations, and mandatory completion of the Drinking Driver Program.

On January 27, 2017, GREEN pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class D Felony.

On December 29, 2016, at approximately 12:36 A.M., members of the Albany Police Department conducted a traffic stop for a 2008 black Dodge Caravan operated by GREEN that was speeding on Central Avenue in the City of Albany. Officers observed that GREEN displayed physical signs of intoxication. GREEN admitted to drinking 3 beers prior to operating the vehicle.

At the time of the arrest, GREEN was serving a term of Probation Supervision from a prior DWI felony conviction.

Vehicular Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter prosecuted this case.
