Ryan Gunn Arraigned On Attempted Murder Charges



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that RYAN GUNN was arraigned on (1) Count of Attempted Murder in the Second Degree, a Class B Armed Violent

Felony, (2) Counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, both Class C Armed Violent Felony, (1) Criminal Use of a Firearm in the First Degree, a Class B Armed Felony, (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Violent Armed Felony and (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Armed Violent Felony before Judge Dan Lamont in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On November 12, 2012, the indictment alleges GUNN and a neighbor that he knew allegedly began to argue in the area of Second Avenue in the City of Albany. GUNN allegedly went back to his house, retrieved a firearm and fired at his neighbor, hitting the individual in the shoulder.

GUNN faces up to 25 years in State Prison if convicted on all charges and is remanded without bail to the Albany County Supreme Court.

Assistant District Attorney Benjamin Mastaitis of the Major Offenses Bureau is prosecuting the case.
