Sentencing for Illegal Weapon after Colonie Traffic Stop



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KENYON MYERS, 30, of Schenectady, was sentenced to 4 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, as a second felony offender, before the Honorable Roger McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On March 11, 2015, MYERS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Armed Felony.

On July 23, 2014, at approximately 6:25am, in the area Troy-Schenectady Road and Knadler Drive in the Town of Colonie, MYERS was riding as a passenger of a vehicle that was stopped

for vehicle and traffic violations by Colonie Police Officers. Officers uncovered a loaded Cobra .380 semi-automatic pistol under the passenger seat, which was determined to illegally be in MYERS' possession.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
