Sentencing in Domestic Homicide Case



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAMIEN ZERVOS, 32, of Albany, was sentenced to 25 years in State Prison, before the Honorable Judge Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On April 16, 2015, ZERVOS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Manslaughter in the First Degree, a Class B Felony.

On October 31, 2013, at a residence on Lark Street in the City of Albany, the defendant did cause the death of Charee Akins-Maddox, 33, of Albany by shooting her with a rifle. At the

time of the incident the victim's four children were inside the home.

Special Victims Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Sarfoh prosecuted this case.
