Teenager Faces State Prison for Vehicular Assault



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ZACKERY DAVIS-TODD, 18, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Vehicular Assault in the Second Degree, a Class E Felony before the Honorable Thomas Breslin in Albany County Court this afternoon.

On May 6, 2012, DAVIS-TODD, while under the influence of marijuana, turned left at a traffic light that was red at the time for left turns, and turned directly in the front of the path of a motorcyclist, causing the motorcyclist to crash into the defendant's car. The victim was seriously injured in the collision.

DAVIS-TODD faces 1 1/3 to 4 years in State Prison when sentenced on March 27, 2013.

Bureau Chief of the Vehicular Crimes unit Mary Tanner-Richter prosecuted this case.
