Tire Iron Assault Leads to 10 Year Prison Sentence



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ANTOINE RAY, 44, of Albany, was sentenced to 10 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 22, 2016, RAY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

On May 1, 2016, at approximately 12:05 A.M., a physical altercation took place near the corner of Central Avenue and Quail Street in the City of Albany. During the incident RAY struck an adult male that was present multiple times in the head with a metal tire iron. The attack caused injury consisting of a fractured skull, which required approximately 20 staples to repair. The victim was treated and survived.

Assistant District Attorney Dennis DiBari of the Major Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
